## Scholarship Eligibility and Selection Information

- The goal of our scholarship program is to support students pursuing a degree or certification (to any trade school, accredited college or university) in a construction related field.
- Scholarships are awarded in an amount *up to* \$1000.00 per semester, and a maximum of 4 years total.
- This scholarship is open to employees of member companies as well as children of employees of member companies. All applicants will be considered, but preference for scholarships goes to construction related fields.
- Scholarships are awarded for the upcoming Fall/Spring semesters. If awarded a scholarship, checks will be made payable to both the student and the academic establishment. In order to receive the amount for the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester, it is up to the student to provide fall transcripts and spring enrollment verification *no later* than January 31<sup>st</sup>. If you fail to provide your transcript by the date listed you forfeit your remaining scholarship funds for that academic year.
- Scholarship recipients must maintain a 3.0 Cumulative GPA.
- You may be asked to donate your time and participate at yearly events. (See our website for a list of our annual events)
